AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND PARAGRAPH (B), "NEIGHBORHOOD DISTRICTS," OF §12.33, "SAGINAW HUMAN PLANNING COMMISSION", OF CHAPTER 12, "BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS", OF TITLE I, ADMINISTRATIVE CODE OF THE CITY OF SAGINAW CODE OF ORDINANCES, O-1.

The City of Saginaw ordains:

Section 1. Paragraph (B), "Neighborhood Districts", of §12.33 "Saginaw Human Planning Commission" of Chapter 12, "Boards and Commissions" of Title I, Administrative Code of the City of Saginaw Code of Ordinances, O-1, is hereby amended to read as follows:
