WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission ("Commission") held a public hearing on March 28, 2003, on a proposal to vacate a 95' portion of the alley bounded by South Harrison Street, Van Buren Street, South Webster Street and Mackinaw Street, abutting the properties known as 421 and 429 South Harrison Street, 415 South Harrison Street, 714 Mackinaw Street and 416 South Webster Street, in the City of Saginaw; and

WHEREAS, after a duly advertised public hearing, the Commission found that the public and private interest would best be served by the requested alley vacation.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that City Council hereby declares its intent to vacate a 95' portion of the alley bounded by South Harrison Street, Van Buren Street, South Webster Street, and Mackinaw Street, abutting the properties known as 421 and 429 South Harrison Street, 415 South Harrison Street, 714 Mackinaw Street and 416 South Webster Street, in the City of Saginaw.
