Subject: Amendment to Human Planning Commission Ordinance.

Manager's Recommendation:

I recommended that Paragraph (B), "Neighborhood Districts", of §12.33 "Saginaw Human Planning Commission" of Chapter 12, "Boards and Commissions" of Title I, Administrative Code of the City of Saginaw Code of Ordinances, O-1 be amended. The reason for this amendment is described below. An Ordinance has been prepared and appears under the regular order of business.

Justification:

In June 2007, City Council adopted a new ordinance for the Saginaw Human Planning Commission. The ordinance established 20 districts for membership based upon the then 20 polling precincts located in the City. Since that time, City Council approved the addition of two (2) precincts and the relocation of several others either to better accommodate voters or due to school closures. Giving the foregoing, the Saginaw Human Planning Commission ordinance is being amended to reflect these changes.
