Subject: Public Safety Management Options Analysis Agreement.

Manager's Recommendation:

I recommend approval of the Agreement for Public Safety Management Options Analysis with the International City/County Management Association and to allow the City Manager or his designee to execute the Agreement and related documents. This contract has been approved by me as to substance and the City Attorney as to form.

Justification:

As a result of the direction given by the City Council in its Strategic Planning Session, the administration has been reviewing the provision of public safety services by the City of Saginaw. Part of that review is the investigation of current service levels, costs and potential reorganizations. The City has negotiated an agreement with the International City/County Management Association to conduct a study and provide a report that the City may utilize to further this process.

The cost of this study will be \$28,000, and the funds are available in the present Budget. The initial draft will be available by April 15, 2006. This is a personal services agreement and not subject to the requirement of competitive bidding.
