Presented Ricardo Bowen of Health Delivery with proclamation designating March 2-8, 2008 as African Americans AIDS Awareness Week.

Held public hearing on Special Single Lot Assessment Tax Roll.

Granted personal appearances to Johnny Sanders, Roma Thurin and Michael Marsh.

Reappointed Abraham Allen to the DDA until 12/31/12.

Heard reports from Keep Saginaw Beautiful Committee, Cities of Promise, Crime Prevention Council and Charter Review Committee.

Approved writing off the balance from 2 residential rehabilitation loans deemed uncollectible.
