REGULAR MEETING OF CITY OF SAGINAW COUNCIL HELD  
MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 22, 2008, 6:30 P.M. COUNCIL CHAMBER, CITY HALL

Held public hearings on Mistequay Group LTD, CMI-Schneible Group, and TRW Integrated Chassis Systems, requests for an Industrial Facilities Tax Exemption Certificates and adopted resolutions for same, along with one for Prints Plus, Inc.

Granted personal appearances to Earl Jesse, Johnny Sanders, Sydney Johnson, Bishop Alvernis L. Johnson, Linda Hamacher, Cherrie Benchley, Vicki Jones, Debra Melkonian and Larry Campbell.

Agreed to send a Resolution to Liquor Control Commission on increased concentration of liquor establishments with a GIS map attached depicting liquor license locations and crime.

Received and filed and referred to the City Manager Petition from Rifkin Scrap Iron and Metal, requesting parcels along Washington Avenue be designated an Industrial Development District and announced a public hearing for 10/6/08.

Approved agreements with Saginaw Housing Commission, Ikon Office Solutions, Dixon Engineering, Inc. and Thomas Roofing.

Approved budget adjustments for Andersen Enrichment Center.

Issued purchase orders to Jade Scientific and Hoffman's Power Equipment, Increased Cemetery Rates and Charges.

Introduced ordinance repealing Low Income Housing Tax Exemption for Tabernacle Missionary Baptist Church

Adopted Resolutions accepting HUD Funds for Special Project (EDI-SP), and approving PA 328 transfer exemption of new personal property from Delphi Automotive Systems, LLC, to TRW Integrated Chassis Systems, LLC.
