THE POSITION

The City of Saginaw is currently recruiting potential candidates for consideration in the event of future Police Officer vacancies. This is professional and community oriented work in the prevention of crime and enforcement of local, state, and federal laws. Duties involve protection of life and property through enforcement of laws and ordinances, performance of routine patrol duties, investigation of crimes and accidents, and traffic enforcement; all within guidelines of established departmental rules. Duties also involve constant public contact in the performance of work under potentially stressful situations.

REQUIREMENTS

- Must meet one of the following criteria: A) proof of current Police Officer status; B) valid proof of satisfactory completion of an acknowledged police academy.
- Prior urban police experience is greatly preferred.
- Must be at least 18 years of age.
- Must be a citizen of the United States.
- Must be a high school graduate or possess a GED equivalent.
- Must have a valid Michigan driver's license and a satisfactory driving record.
- Must meet all Michigan Commission on Law Enforcement Standards (MCOLES) current physical standards.

- Include a cover letter and detailed resume containing information regarding your education, certifications, prior work experience and professional references.
- Proof of officer certification or academy completion must be included with your application.
- Screened in applicants will undergo a written test; those satisfactorily completing the written test will advance to an oral interview.
- Upon selection, the following components must be satisfactorily completed: background investigation; physical exam; psychological exam; state certified drug screening.
