

Election Information

August 7, 2018 Primary Election

- **Tuesday, July 9** – Last Day to Register to Vote.
- **Saturday, August 4 at 2:00 p.m.** – Deadline to submit an application for qualified electors who wish to receive an absent voter ballot by mail. The City Clerk's Office will be open from 9:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.
- **Monday, August 6 at 4:00 p.m.** – Deadline for qualified electors to obtain an absent voter ballot and vote in person in the Clerk's office.
- **Tuesday, August 7 at 4:00 p.m.** – Deadline for emergency absentee voting for election.

November 6, 2018 General Election

City Council will have four Council Member seats on the ballot each for a 4-year term expiring 2022. These are non-partisan positions and members are elected at-large. Candidates must be a registered voter of the City of Saginaw.

Saginaw Public School Board will have three positions on the ballot each for a 6-year term expiring 2024, and one partial term expiring 2020. These are non-partisan positions. Candidates must be a registered voter of the City of Saginaw, City of Zilwaukee, Kochville Township, or Buena Vista Township Precincts 2 & 3.

Nominating Petitions and Affidavit of Identity forms are available at the Saginaw City Clerk's Office and must be filed with the City Clerk.

- **Tuesday, August 7 – Council Candidates** filing deadline at 5:00 p.m. Petitions must be filed at the City Clerk's Office.
- **Tuesday, July 24 – School Board Candidates** filing deadline at 4:00 p.m. Petitions must be filed at the City Clerk's Office.
- **Monday, October 9** – Last Day to Register to Vote.
- **Saturday, November 3 at 2:00 p.m.** – Deadline to submit an application for qualified electors who wish to receive an absent voter ballot by mail. The City Clerk's Office will be open from 9:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.
- **Monday, November 5 at 4:00 p.m.** – Deadline for qualified electors to obtain an absent voter ballot and vote in person in the Clerk's office.
- **Tuesday, November 6 at 4:00 p.m.** – Deadline for emergency absentee voting for election.
