JUNE 16 NEIGHBORHOOD ASSOCIATION ACTION GROUP MEETING TO BE HELD AT BLISS PARK

June 12, 2020 SAGINAW, MI – The City of Saginaw will host the upcoming Neighborhood Association Action Group meeting LIVE under the pavilion at Bliss Park, at the corner of Houghton Street and Michigan Avenue, beginning at 12:00pm on Tuesday, June 16.

The City of Saginaw is pleased to once again host a Neighborhood Association Action Group (NAAG) meeting for area residents. The meetings were previously canceled due to COVID-19 restrictions. The June NAAG meeting will allow residents from area neighborhood groups to reconvene once again to learn, discuss local neighborhood issues, solve problems, and reconnect with one another. Meeting participants are asked to wear an appropriate face covering and adhere to social distancing guidelines.

The agenda for Tuesday's NAAG meeting will include a variety of beneficial topics including updates from local law enforcement and the fire department, the City's plan for reopening, and Saginaw's "Best Kept Yard" program. Residents will also have the opportunity to ask questions of many of our department heads, as we will have representatives from several departments in attendance. In addition, participants at the

noon NAAG meeting can treat themselves to a delicious lunch from food trucks that will be at Bliss Park for the occasion. Local favorites like Ruth's Grilled Hot Dogs, TNT Authentic Mexican, 3 Lil Pigs BBQ, and Woody's Hot Dogs will be there for residents to enjoy. The food trucks will be on site from 11:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.

John Stemple, Director of Neighborhood Services and Inspections, stressed the importance of the June NAAG meeting, "We felt this meeting was crucial to the future of our neighborhoods. There are many serious topics that we need to discuss and goals to be established. We want citizens to know that we are here to listen to them. Everyone who attends can make a valuable contribution to their neighborhood and to the city."

Stemple hopes the meeting will also be a celebration, "We, as a community, have experienced many challenges in the past six months. The June NAAG meeting will allow our neighborhood groups to come together, while six-feet apart, and celebrate. Not only all that we've done, but all that we plan to do."
