SAGINAW CITY HALL INSTALLS UPGRADED CAMERA SYSTEM

March 8, 2019 SAGINAW, MI – The City of Saginaw Technical Services Department along with the Public Services Facilities Division have worked together to complete the latest upgrade at City Hall. This enhancement includes the replacement of all existing analog security cameras with new, high definition Internet Protocol cameras as well as installing additional camera locations in both the interior and exterior of City Hall, 1315 S. Washington Avenue.

The installation work began the week of February 18 and is now complete. The new high definition Internet Protocol (IP) cameras can immediately transmit images directly to a computer via the Internet and will provide a digital, high definition layer of security throughout City Hall. The IP cameras feature a superior image detail compared to the traditional analog cameras, which are often grainy and difficult to distinguish for finer features. Additionally, the IP cameras can display a wider range of view, covering an area that would take multiple analog cameras to observe.

Along with replacing existing analog cameras, additional cameras were also installed in the basement of City Hall, elevator corridors, the east parking lot in the rear of the building, the parking lot across on Holland Avenue, and at the front entrance of City Hall facing Washington Avenue.

City Manager Tim Morales commented, “The City of Saginaw strives to provide a safe and secure environment for our employees and our citizens. As a public building, we realize that we have hundreds of citizens and employees in and out of this building each week. The new security cameras will allow us to observe every area of City Hall and closely monitor activity throughout the building and parking areas.”

Future improvements to City Hall include lighting enhancements and replacing the doors in both the east and west entrances. Plans are also in place for additional cameras to be installed in the Public Works building at 1435 S. Washington Avenue later this year.
