SAGINAW'S SPLASH PARK OPENING DELAYED

May 22, 2019 SAGINAW, MI – The traditional Memorial Day weekend opening of Saginaw's Splash Park, located in the Frank N. Andersen Celebration Park, 1830 Fordney Street, is postponed due to below average temperatures and excessive rainfall this spring that resulted in construction delays.

Necessary repairs to sections of the splash pad, which require warm and dry weather conditions, were delayed over the last two months due to below average temperatures and an extremely wet spring. The repairs are now underway, and expected to be completed within the next few weeks.

Bruce Caradine, Facilities Administrator commented, "We want to make sure the required repairs to two damaged water features' underground piping is completed properly so that the public can enjoy the new and improved features at the park throughout the entire summer. We're excited to open but the weather just hasn't cooperated with our best plans."
