### **City of Saginaw Reminds Residents of Available City Services**

**MAY 27, 2020 SAGINAW, MI** – Governor Whitmer has signed executive order 2020-100, extending her prior “Stay Home, Stay Safe” order through June 12. During this time, citizens can be assured that essential city services are continuing. City staff members are available to assist citizens with their questions and concerns. Citizens can dial **(989) 399-1311** and follow the prompts to speak directly with a department representative.

Trash collection, yard waste and recycling, which are essential services, are continuing as usual. Residents are reminded to have all properly prepared materials placed at the curb no later than 7 am on their regular collection day. The City of Saginaw’s convenience station will remain closed until the executive order is lifted. If the order is lifted on June 12, the next drop off date for City of Saginaw residents is ***tentatively*** scheduled for **Saturday, June 13 8:00 a.m. to noon**.

The City of Saginaw is committed to maintaining basic operations that are necessary to sustain or protect life in our city. All operations maintaining in-person activities must adopt social distancing practices and other mitigation measures to protect employees and citizens.

City Manager Tim Morales commented, “I am proud of our staff and their commitment to serve our citizens throughout this pandemic. We want to ensure our citizens that they will still have access to essential services needed to keep our community healthy and safe.”
